About

CoCo BT1 provides real-time monitoring of Heart Rate, Temperature, and Sleep. It also tracks your activity throughout the day to ensure you get enough exercise.



Getting Started

Charge the Watch completely before initial use. It may take as long as 3 hours for the initial charge.

To charge, put the Watch into the charging box and close the cover (as the below diagram) and plug the other end into a USB port or adapter. The charging screen will display the battery level.



Power on: Method 1: When charging, the Watch will automatically turn on. Method 2: Press and hold the crown button for 3 seconds.



Power off:

To turn off the device, swipe down from the Watch face screen and select the power function. Then press the power button.



Download CoCo Mobile App

To connect your mobile device to CoCo BT1, install the CoCo Mobile App onto your mobile device. The App is compatible with both Android and iOS devices.

Method 1:

Search the App Store or Google Play for "CoCo semcorel" and install the App.

Method 2:

Open the Camera App on your phone and scan the QR-code below.

Open the App once it has downloaded and follow the instructions on the next page to pair your mobile phone with your CoCo BT1.



How to pair with CoCo App

Open CoCo App, Choose Settings. (1) Add Devices. (2) Choose BT1. (3) You could pair BT1 either by scanning QR-code, or Manual connection.



You could find the QR-code in the second Menu page of the Watch as below.



How to Navigate

CoCo BT1 shows user's real-time body temperature, heart rate, daily activity steps, date and time on the Watch Screen.

The main operation of CoCo BT1 is shown below. Swiping the screen can change the function.

To go to the Menu page, swipe left. Swipe right or press the crown button once to return to the Watch Screen.

To go to the Activity Record page, swipe right. Swipe right again or press the crown button once to return to the Watch Screen.

To go to the Settings page, swipe down. Swipe up or press the crown button once to return to the Watch Screen.

To go to the Messages page, swipe up. Swipe down or press the crown button once to return to the Watch Screen.

To switch between different Menu pages, swipe up and down. Swipe right or press the crown button once to return to the Watch Screen.

To go to the function page, tap the icon on the Watch Screen.

To go back to the last page, press the crown button once.

To select an exercise, tap the exercise icon and choose the type you want.



To set a target for mileage, time, or calories, tap the type and set a goal. The exercise will start recording in 3 seconds.

To exercise with open targets, tap Start. The exercise will start recording in 3 seconds.



To stop recording an exercise, tap the pause icon in the upper right corner. To continue, tap the continue icon in the upper right corner. To stop the recording, tap the stop icon in the the upper left corner.



If the recording time is too short, the watch screen will indicate 'Too little data to be saved'.



If the recording is saved, the watch screen will show the result.





How to Measure

Heart Rate

From the first menu page, tap Health. The screen will show '—BPM'. After 2 seconds, the heart rate measurement will start.

The data will show directly on the screen when the heart rate measurement is complete and will continue until you cancel.

If you wish to stop the measurement, please swipe to the right and return to the previous page.

If you want to view your history, tap the icon on the top right corner of the heart rate page to display your real-time heart rate.









Blood Oxygen*

From the first menu page, tap Health. The screen will show '—-'. After 2 seconds, the blood oxygen measurement will start.

The data will show directly on the screen when the blood oxygen measurement is complete and will continue until you cancel.

If you wish to stop the measurement, please swipe to the right and return to the previous page.

If you want to view your history, tap the icon on the top right corner of the blood oxygen page to display your real-time blood oxygen level.



*: Blood Oxygen measurements are not intended for medical use, including self-diagnosis or consultation with a doctor, and are only designed for general fitness and wellness purposes.

Body Temperature

From the third menu page, tap Tempera-ture.

Please wear the watch for more than 15 minutes for the measurement. If less than 15 minutes, the measurement will fail.

Tap'v'to start the measurement or tap 'x' to return to the menu page.



Medication Reminder

CoCo BT1 supports medication reminders which are synchronized with the settings in the CoCo Mobile App. When the time comes, the watch screen will show the medication details. Tapping next will display the remaining reminders. Press the crown button once to return to watch screen.

All the messages and reminders you receive are kept in the Messages box.



Emergency Help*

Pressing the crown button for more than 3 seconds will start an emergency help call. Or click the "Call ECT" icon from the watch screen of CoCo BT1.



*: The ECT team has to be preconfigured in CoCo Mobile App.
